Prof Greg Foliente is Professorial Fellow in the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology at the University of Melbourne in Australia, and Golden Jubilee Honorary Professor at the De La Salle University in the Philippines. He currently serves as President and Board Chair for the non-profit International Initiative for a Sustainable Built Environment (iiSBE). An interdisciplinary scientist and scholar of global standing, he is a recipient of the prestigious James Croes Medal from the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE), amongst other awards, and listed in Stanford University's world ranking of top 2% scientists based on his published work in Scopus. With over three decades of experience leading and facilitating the development of national and international research agenda in various sectors and domains, he is an expert consultant to UN agencies and other international institutions. He currently serves on the editorial board of 5 international journals. He previously worked at Virginia Tech and the University of California in Berkeley in the US, and the Australian national science agency, the CSIRO. He received a BSc in Civil Engineering at Mapua University (Philippines) and two MSc and PhD degrees at Virginia Tech (USA), and executive leadership and management training at the Australian Institute of Company Directors and the MIT Sloan Executive Education.
