Born in Miyanoshita, Iyo City, Ehime Prefecture, Kuninori Takechi went to a high school in Matsuyama after leaving local primary and secondary schools. After entering a technical school in Tokyo, he returned to his hometown to join a local traffic safety facility company. He promoted to the managing director, and engaged in road related businesses in the prefecture.

On 1st April, 2005, he won the election of the Iyo City Council after the annexation of former Nakayama and Futami towns. He was active in various committees. In June 2011, he became the vice chair and worked in the Iyo City Government for a year. Next year, he assumed the General Affairs Committee Chair and kept on more active with his political motto “On-site-first. Change if I set out”. In April 2013, he won the mayor of Iyo City for the first time, then worked for 3 terms (12 years) with the slogan of “The City where 30,000 people can live comfortably” despite various challenges with fewer people and declining birthrate. He also declared “Zero Carbon City”, focusing on policies with promoting SDGs including more renewable energy sources to build a safer and more secure town for the residents.

In April 2025, he won the mayor 4th times, and now he is tackling his job with his whole body and soul under the slogan of “Beyond Iyo City, expanding the bond and our future”.

伊予市長武智邦典氏は、伊予市宮下に生を受け、地元の伊予小・中学校卒業後、松山市にある高校に進学。卒業後東京の専門学校に進学しましたが、故郷に帰り松山市の交通安全施設工事会社に入社。常務取締役となり愛媛県内の道路関連の業務に従事。

2005年（平成17年）4月市議会議員選挙に初当選。2011年（平成23年）6月から1年間副議長として市政に携わり、「即現場、即対応。動けば変わる」を政治信念として活動する。

2013 年（平成 25 年）4 月に伊予市長に初当選、3 期 12 年伊予市政のトップとして少子化、人口減少という大きな課題に直面する中、「3 万人が住み続けられる伊予市」という目標を掲げ、更に「ゼロカーボンシティ宣言」を行うなど、再生可能エネルギー・SDGs を基準とした政策に重点を置き、市民の安全安心なまちづくりの推進に努める。

2025 年（令和 7 年）4 月に 4 期目の伊予市長当選を果たし、「Beyond Iyo City」～繋が り 広がる伊予市の未来～を掲げ、獅子奮迅の如く全身全霊で伊予市政に取り組んでいる。
